

## The University of Liverpool and HELP University LLB Law programme

The University of Liverpool and HELP University, have a credit transfer programme, offering HELP University students the opportunity to enter the University of Liverpool's prestigious LLB law programme in either Year 2 or 3 (1+2 and 2+1).

### **Entry requirements**

- ❖ Year 2 entry: 50% overall and only ONE re-sit with mitigating circumstances will be considered. IELTS 6.5 or equivalent (minimum band Scores 5.5)
- ❖ Year 3 entry: 60% overall and only ONE re-sit with mitigating circumstances will be considered. IELTS 6.5 or equivalent (minimum band Scores 5.5)

### **Application process**

### Fees and costs

- Fixed fee guarantee: this means the fee level will not increase over the time that you are studying with us
- ❖ The UKBA now state that applications will now need to prove that they can fund living costs of £1,023 per month until the duration of the course.

# \*\*Contribution towards travel costs and £1,000 discount from fees for HELP University Students\*\*

All direct entry students (whether coming into years 2 or 3) will be awarded £500 towards their travel costs to the UK and receive £1,000 discount from their fees (for one year) if they satisfy 2 conditions:

- 1. The student, regardless of year 2 or year 3 entry, **must accept** the UoL offer as 'firm,' and
- 2. Register with the LLS onto one of the LLB degree programmes offered.

## \*\*Vice Chancellors Attainment Scholarship\*\*

All direct entry students will be eligible for the VC Award if they obtain: -

Year 2 entry - achieve 55% overall with no module below 50% Year 3 entry - achieve 62% overall with no module below 58%

THE £1000 AWARD AND VC AWARD £2500 WILL BE TAKEN OFF THE TUITION FEES AND THE £500 WILL BE CLAIMED ON ARRIVAL AND REGISTRATION AT THE LAW SCHOOL

### \*\*University of Liverpool First Class Scholarship\*\*

Students coming into YEAR 2 ONLY will be eligible to receive £1,000 from the tuition fees if a First Class average is maintained (70%) when they enter their third year of study.

PLEASE NOTE: - Students can be eligible for the £500 travel costs AND £1,000 fee reduction AND UOL scholarships AND VC Attainment Award AND University of Liverpool First Class Scholarship.

# The University of Liverpool and HELP University \*\*Scholarship competition\*\*

This is a scholarship exclusively for HELP students on the LLB Law programme at the University of Liverpool. There is ONE scholarship available for 2024-25.

- ❖ The scholarship will be £5,000 for one academic year. The students will need to cover all living costs and any costs incurred by extended study for whatever reason
- The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Dean of the Law School
- The criteria are:
  - 1. Exam performance and results with at least 58% in year 1 for transfers into year 2 and 68% in year 2 for transfers into year 3.

- 2. Contribution to the student community at University
- ❖ This scholarship competition is open to all students from HELP University who apply for a place on the LLB Law programme at the University of Liverpool. To be eligible, the University of Liverpool will need to have first received your application for a place and you must have confirmed this place.
- ❖ To apply for the scholarship, all applicants need to complete an application form and to submit a 200 word personal statement
- The closing date is 6 September 2024.
