


## Singapore

For the LPC you must hold a qualifying law degree or a GDL or similar qualification.

For the Bar Professional Training Course, you will need a qualifying English law degree (2:2 minimum) or an international equivalent from an approved Law School.



## **Practising Certificate**

To practise law in Singapore, you must have first applied for and obtained a practising certificate ('PC') issued by the Registrar of the Supreme Court (the 'Registrar').

A PC is required to be applied for every practice year commencing 1 April of a calendar year and ending 31 March the following calendar year. A PC for any practice year may therefore commence on any date after 1 April of a calendar year but will automatically expire every 31 March of the following calendar year.
